Meeting Minutes

October 20th, 2016

Meeting called to order at 4:30pm by Supervisor, Lynn M Norton

In attendance at the meeting was, Supervisor Lynn M. Norton, Treasurer Sherry L. Hampton, Clerk Julie L. Norton, Trustee Russell Johnson, Trustee Debra Huebner, Fire Chief Allen Schultz, Twp. Maintenance person Glen Hanson, Gloria Hanson, David Johnson, Schoolcraft Co. Sheriff John Norrington, Connie Frenette representing the Senior Center, Patti Hoffman.

Connie Frenette talked about the proposed 20 yr. millage for .90 mills. The millage is for new additions and improvements the millage would bring in \$329,074.00. Frenette informed the board of the many services the center provides for local seniors and the need for to improve and expand the current center.

Treasurer Hampton presented written reports on the tax acc., the fire acc., General fund, & the tax account.

Trustee Huebner reported hall rentals for November 5th, and for the election on November 8th.

Fire Chief Schultz reported a total of 40 runs to date, for 2016. Chief also talked about needing a newer 1st responder truck for the fire dept. the current truck is a 1995. Board members are looking into this.

There will be a bake sale to benefit the fire Dept. on November 11th & 12th at BG's feed store. **Bakers and customers needed.** All proceeds to the Doyle Twp. Fire Dept.

Supervisor Norton reported the State of Michigan AMAR report came back, all items have been corrected by Assessor Joseph Maki and the next review will take place in 2020.

The Board hired Don's Auto to plow the hall and the fire Dept. for the 16/17 winter.

Supervisor Norton presented a plan for the finishing of the Kelly Road. The board approved the new contract with the Schoolcraft County Road Commission.

Trustee Johnson made a motion to pay for Doyle Twp. residents to skate at Little Bear Arena again this year. Clerk Norton supported this motion. Motion carried.

With no other business coming before the board, a motion made by Johnson to adjourn at 5:25pm, supported by Hampton. Motion carried.
